### What a Peer Advisor Is:

Peer Advisors for the Money Education (ME) Center are trained student workers who educate their fellow Aggies about critical financial concepts through presentations, resource tables, walk-in advising, and private appointments. Peer Advisors gain valuable public speaking and personal financial advising experience while directly contributing to the financial wellness of their peers. Starting pay for these positions is \$8/hour.

### Minimum Requirements for Consideration:

- Strong communication skills, and a passion for educating and helping others.
- Enrolled as an Undergraduate at Texas A&M University (College Station campus).
- Eligible for Work Study funds (which require financial need).
- Completed (or in the process of completing) ***ONE*** of the following courses:
  - Foundations of Money Education (AGEC 235)
  - Financial Readiness (AGEC 335)
  - Financial Planning for Professionals (AGEC 435)
- Available to provide evening and weekend presentations to student groups on occasion.

### Position Expectations:

- Minimum two-semester commitment.
- Work 12-20 hours each week.
- Prefer the ability to work during Summer, but not required.
- Attendance at mandatory trainings.
